

UNITED KINGDOM / EU BREXIT UPDATE – IMPORTANT TRANSITION INFORMATION

As you are no doubt aware, The United Kingdom will be leaving the EU on the 31st of January 2020. We will then enter a transitional period until 31st December 2020.

During the transition period, the importation and exportation of goods between the UK and EU will proceed under the existing rules, meaning that current rules for customs border arrangements, customs clearance, Duty. VAT and excise will remain un-affected until the end of this year.

As of 1st January 2021, the UK will separate from the current EU Customs union. Full details of the post separation procedures and agreements are yet to be finalised and are still under negotiation by the respective countries and states.
